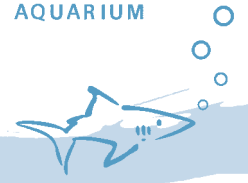


Which defence?

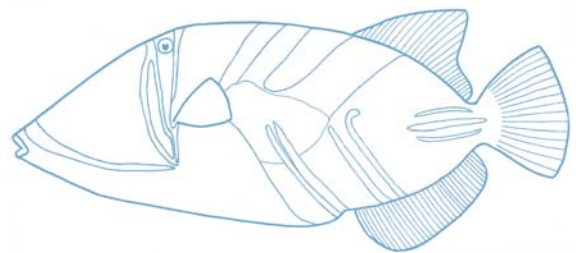


Match up the defensive tactic with the animal, then find the animal in the aquarium and label the species



I can change my colour so that I can blend in with the background, I am also very good at hiding.

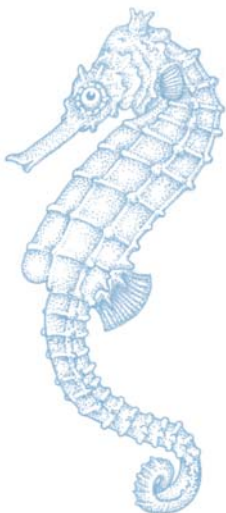
I have a peculiar body shape which makes predators think that I won't be able to fit into their mouths, I am also brightly coloured to warn predators that I am toxic.



I have a sting in my tail, but I can also completely cover myself in sand so that predators can't see me.



I have stripes which help break up my body shape making it harder for predators to see where I begin and where I end.



I use counter shading, the top of my body is dark and the bottom is light so that when looking down you can't see me against the bottom and when looking up at me you can't see me against the surface.
